Structural Change

- Policies: Share about any federal, state, local, or organizational policies that have influenced work in the community. (i.e. organization implemented FI Screening policy, organization implemented policy for improving/regulating nutrition value of food provided)
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- Practices/Resource Flows: Share about any changes in organizational practices or resource flows. (i.e. organization adopted a new resource referral platform for use, organization began collecting new data to better understand the population they serve, new funding for an innovative approach, program pivots as a result of unexpected changes in funding, etc.)
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Relational Change

- Relationships and Connections: Share about any changes that have influenced relationships or connections across organizations, sectors and/or neighbors. (i.e. new coalitions or collaborations started, new partnerships between organizations)
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- Power Dynamics: Share about any changes that have influenced power dynamics between neighbors and organizations or between organizations. (i.e. new opportunities for neighbor listening sessions, etc).
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Transformative Change:

- Mental Models: Share any shifts you have observed in mental models, or the way colleagues or community members are thinking about issues related to the intersection of health, nutrition, and food insecurity. (i.e. recognizing structural barriers to nutrition access, shift towards recognizing role in broader resource ecosystem, etc.)
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
